Please notice: The first semester can also be used as a **Pre-Master** to meet the requirements for other ISM master's programs.



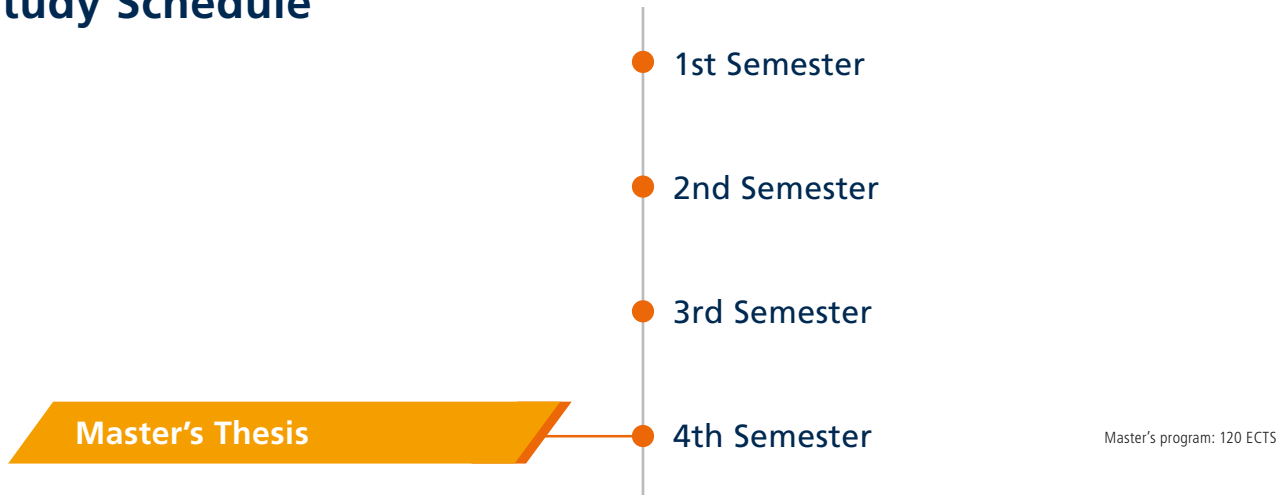

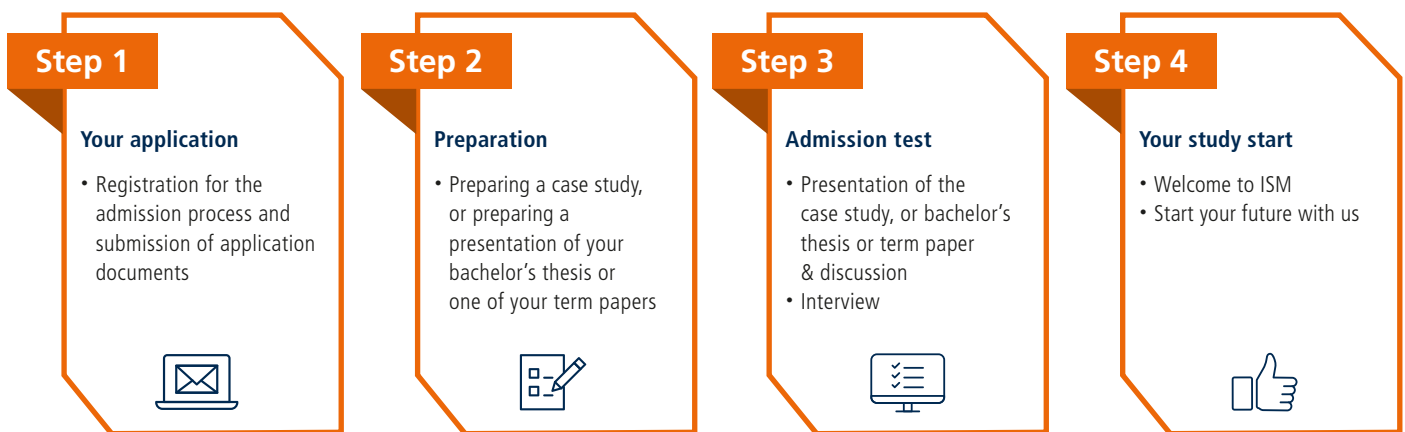

Application Procedure



Admission Requirements

In order to enroll in a master's program at ISM, you must have successfully completed your first university degree with **a minimum study period of six semesters (at least 180 ECTS)** from a university or an equivalent foreign higher education institution.

No previous knowledge of economics is required.

Job Options in Germany

Students from non-EU States:

After graduation, you can apply for an 18-month residence permit to seek a job that matches your qualifications.

Once you have received a job offer that aligns with your qualifications, you will have the option to decide between applying for a German residence permit or an EU Blue Card for the subsequent phase of your stay.

Application Deadline

Applicants who are subject to visa requirements must ensure that their application is submitted by the specified deadlines in the respective year:

Spring term: December 15th

Fall term: July 15th

Applicants without visa obligation or who already have a student visa may apply later.
