

ACCOMMODATION GUIDE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS CAMPUS FRANKFURT



ISM Frankfurt is conveniently located next to the train station in Sachsenhausen (Frankfurt-Süd/ Südbahnhof), making travel to surrounding neighborhoods easy and accessible. The subway, regional trains and trams in front of our door operate in all directions. You will find a map on the last page of this guide that shows you where the different neighborhoods are located.

You should be aware that finding independent accommodation in Frankfurt is not impossible, but does require a considerable amount of effort. If you do not find any accommodation before your arrival to Frankfurt, plan to arrive well before the start of the semester. It is difficult to look for an apartment at the same time as dealing with the start of classes and getting used to a new environment. During your house-hunt you can stay at a backpacker hostel or in any budget hotel near the main station or fair district.

Frankfurt has a high living standard. You must calculate with approx. no less than 450 \in for a furnished room with shared facilities. You can get your own furnished apartment for approx. 750 \in per month.

Please note that you are not eligible to apply for housing at the residences of the **Studentenwerk** Frankfurt. This is because ISM is a private higher education institution and they will only accept applications from public university students (Goethe University, UAS).

But often students of the Studentenwerk residences sublet their rooms for one semester. Due to the fact that you have a student status you may sublet the room. Just watch out on <u>www.wg-gesucht.de</u> for descriptions of student residences: 6 or more flatmates, cheap price, name of the building.



There is an ISM **Facebook** group for housing (search for "ISM Wohnungsmarkt"). Many students from the ISM Frankfurt who spend their semester abroad during the time you will be in Frankfurt are trying to rent their rooms or flats to incoming students. Frankfurt neighborhoods




most expensive / rather expensive / expensive / less expensive / least expensive

Neighboring cities



Neighboring cities with also good connections to ISM and Frankfurt City Center are **Neu-Isenburg** and **Offenbach**, south and southeast of Frankfurt.

The Taunus cities: Bad Homburg + Oberursel + Eschborn + Bad Soden have train connections to ISM, but the commute is with 30-40 minutes rather a big one.

!! Please note !!
