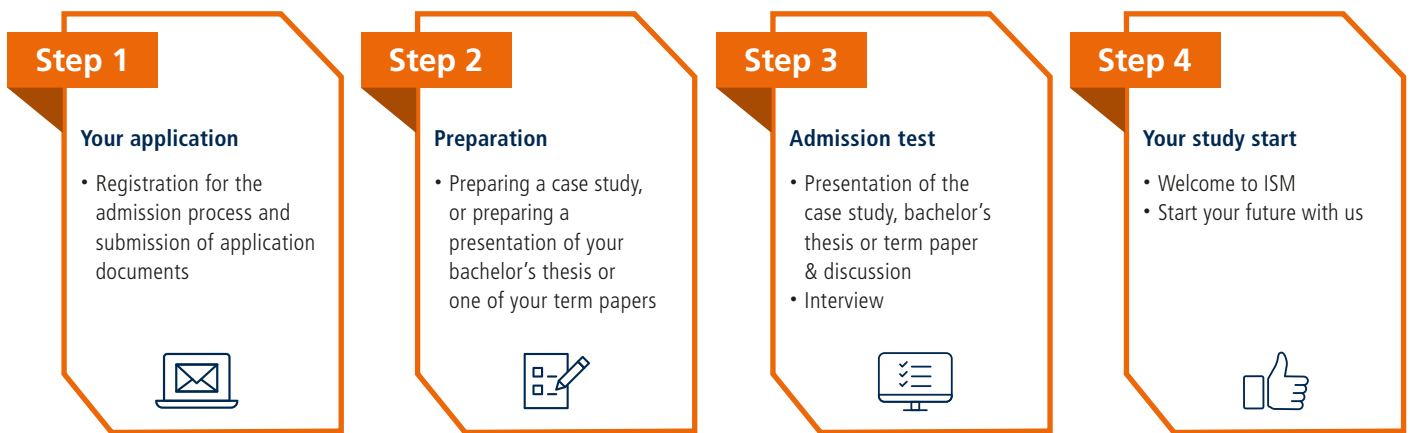

# Admission Requirements

**In order to enroll in the MBA General Management at ISM, applicants must fulfill the following requirements:**

- a first successful degree with 210 ECTS points from a university or an equivalent foreign higher education institution
- at least two years' professional experience after your first degree
- sufficient English language skills, e.g. TOEFL (at least 80 points internet-based) or IELTS (6.0 or better)

Missing ECTS points may be replaced by qualified work experience up to a maximum of 30 ECTS points – in addition to the professional experience required above.

# Job Options in Germany

## Students from non-EU States:

After graduation, you can apply for an 18-month residence permit to seek a job that matches your qualifications.

Once you have received a job offer that aligns with your qualifications, you will have the option to decide between applying for a German residence permit or an EU Blue Card for the subsequent phase of your stay.

# Application Deadline

Applicants who are subject to visa requirements must ensure that their application is submitted by the specified deadlines in the respective year.

**Spring term: December 15th**

**Fall term: July 15th**

Applicants without visa obligation or who already have a student visa may apply later.
