

### **General Information**

- · An internationally recognized research degree
- Further development of specialist knowledge and deep methodological capacity
- Duration: 3 or 4 years full-time
- · Significant original research necessary
- Submission of a substantial research thesis as culmination of the degree

# Cooperation between ISM and IQS

- Possibility for ISM graduates to apply for a PhD program
- Max. 6 candidates per year
- Preselection made by ISM
- Final admission depending on IQS
- Jointly supervision (one supervisor each)
- Delivery of the programs according to IQS' Policy and Code of Practice
- Administrative support provided by ISM

# Admission Criteria & Requirements

### **Admission Criteria**

#### All applicants shall fulfill the following criteria:

- Excellence in academic qualifications (e.g.: minimum GPA 2.0)
- An official undergraduate degree or the equivalent
- · An official Master's degree in a relevant discipline
- A total of 300 ECTS (min. 60 ECTS at Master's level)
- Proof of English language proficiency at min. C1 level
- (IELTS 6.5 or equivalent)
- · A research proposal at an appropriate level for doctoral study
- (to be supervised by both ENU and ISM research staff)
- 2 reference letters (from doctoral degree holders)
- Letter of motivation
- CV



# Requirements

#### Presence at IQS

• Each student has to be present in Barcelona and at IQS for the 3-4 years of the program.

#### Presence at ISM

 You are obliged to attend one module (one week) during February/March at ISM Dortmund (equivalent to 10 ECTS).

#### **Master in Research**

 Students that have not studied a Master in Research, must complete a course of 12 ECTS on Quantitative and Qualitative Research Methodology (no additional costs).

#### **Compulsory Courses**

Students must attend a compulsory course of Ethics in Research, and 2
courses per year, at least 6 courses during all the PhD program of 10 hours
each one. These courses can be taken at any of the three universities in the
program and also at other universities. Students will always have to present
a certificate to validate it.

# Before completing the PhD thesis and be allowed to proceed to its defence, the candidate must have for the traditional way:

- 1. at least one article published or accepted to be published in an indexed peer-reviewed research journal (JCR)
- 2. presented a communication in an international conference
- 3. presented the PhD work-in progress in an IQS research seminar every year.

# Before completing the PhD thesis and be allowed to proceed to its defence, the candidate must have through the compendium of papers:

- 1. three articles published in an indexed peer-reviewed research journal (JCR)
- 2. presented a communication in an international conference
- 3. presented the PhD work-in progress in an IQS research seminar every year.



### **Timeline**

- Contact your ISM supervisor as early as possible to allow sufficient time for the preparation of your final research proposal.
- Applications for the PhD program can be submitted from January 8th.
- Deadline for applications to IQS is July 24th.
